

Centennial Commons Pool Rules

Current Pool Rules are posted in bulletin board in clubhouse breezeway

Pool Hours will be posted at entrance to the pool

Summer hours will be 9 AM to 9 PM

off season May – Late Aug & Sept. pool hours will open & close earlier

1. Any abuse of the pool facility or the contents within or failure to follow instructions from those in charge of the pool (Board of Directors and volunteers) including lifeguards and pool monitors will result in immediate expulsion and possible deactivation of entrance key, fines and other legal actions. Homeowners will be liable for damage caused by their guests or family.
2. Admission to the pool is allowed only with an activated swipe key by a homeowner or their family members living with them. **All guests must be accompanied by a resident. Only 4 guests are allowed per household.**
3. You are not allowed to let others in. If your key has been disabled you are not allowed to enter the pool as a guest of another resident.
4. Lifeguards and/or Pool Monitors will be staffed during hours of operation when possible. **When lifeguards are not present you will be using the pool at your own risk. Pool Monitors are not lifeguards!**
5. You will report to the Pool Monitor, if one is available, when entering and provide your street number and give names of the attendees with you. This is to comply with Centennial Commons amenities waiver program.
6. During thunder and or lightning the pool must be cleared and remain clear for 30 minutes after the last event before entering again.
7. **No glass or breakable containers are allowed inside the fenced-in pool area.**
8. No smoking allowed except at the designated smoking area.

Pool Rules Cont'd

9. **Children not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.** A discussion with your children about the importance of using the bathroom before it's too late should be held by the homeowner. Dispose of diapers outside of the pool area in bathroom waste containers.

10. **Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) and the adult must be present at all times when children are in the pool area.**

11. Children 14 to 17 years old may use the pool without supervision but are limited to two (2) guests at a time.

12. No food or drinks are allowed in the pool.

13. No diving, running, horseplay, abusive or vulgar language will be allowed. No scooters, skateboards, skates or bicycles are allowed inside the pool gate or breezeway.

14. Only items intended to be used in a pool are permitted. No hard objects are allowed to be thrown in the pool or pool area. This includes hard balls such as baseballs, footballs and basketballs. Softer smaller versions of these items are permitted in the pool. Throwing objects should be limited to the playing group and not be thrown in the direction of others. Any violators will be asked to stop the activity.

15. Homeowners who wish to have more than 4 guests must make prior arrangements with the Board of Directors. Large parties may require additional pool staff if available.

16. Music should be played at a moderate level and be family friendly. No vulgar language.

Pool Rules Cont'd

17. All swimmers should shower before using the pool.
18. Persons with any types of communicable diseases are not allowed to use the pool. No body fluids should be expelled into the pool.
19. Only appropriate (family oriented) swimsuits are permitted. No thongs are allowed.
20. Hair more than shoulder length must be secured/tied (ponytail) while in pool.
21. Personal floats are allowed but only when pool capacity is low and will be determined by lifeguard or pool monitor when one is present. Extra Large floats will not be allowed during moderate or high capacity.
22. Only medical service animals are permitted within the pool gate and not in the pool.
23. No solo swimming allowed.
24. While alcohol consumption is allowed, any drunkenness will not be tolerated and county authorities will be called.
